WHAT?

The CPMT serves as a platform for cooperation among Quebec's labour market stakeholders and aims to align training opportunities, workforce skills, and labour market demands.

It participates in the development of government policies, strategic orientations and measures in the fields of labour and employment as well as collaborates on decisions concerning measures and programs that fall under the responsibility of the ministre de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale.

WHO?

The decision-making body of the CPMT is the deliberative assembly. It is made up of the following organizations representing the Quebec labour market:

- employers
- workforce
- educational players
- specialized employability organizations
- economic and social ministries and agencies

WHY?

From the standpoint of fostering comprehensive economic growth and through collaborative efforts, the CPMT oversees workforce and employment programs, especially those that aim to align training opportunities with the skills of workers and the demands of the job market.

It also plays a role in fostering the growth, acknowledgment, and improvement of workforce competencies to meet both present and future labour market needs.
